Nutrition is mainly responsible for climate change and weak health conditions


The situation is severe:

- Hunger and malnutrition: more than 811 million people are facing hunger, two billion people are lacking essential nutrients / vitamins
- on the other hand: 2 billion people suffer from obesity
- Climate: More than one third of greenhouse-gas-emission is resulting from our food system



The Planetary Boundaries concept

presents a set of nine planetary boundaries within which humanity can continue to develop and thrive for generations to come

"Food systems have the potential to nurture human health and support environmental sustainability, however our current agriculture and food production threaten both,"




The EAT-Lancet Commission
